1. The Bidding documents Consisting of qualifying information, eligibility criteria, specifications, Drawings, bill of quantities (B.O.Q), Set of terms and conditions of contract and other details can be seen/downloaded from the departmental website www.jktenders.gov.in as per schedule of dates given below.
2. Bids must be accompanied with cost of Tender document in shape of demand draft in favour of Executive Engineer PHE Division Leh and Earnest money /Bid security in shape of CDR/DR pledged to Distt.Supdg. Engineer PWD Circle,Leh. Payable at Leh.
3. Bidders can resubmit / withdraw the bids as specified.
4. The date and time of opening of Financial-Bids shall be notified on Web Site www.jktenders.gov.in and conveyed to the bidders automatically through an e-mail message on their e-mail address. The **Financial-bids of Responsive bidders** shall be opened online in the Office of Distt Supdg. Engineer PWD Circle office Leh.
5. The bids for the work shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of bids.
6. No Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazette Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the State Government is allowed to work as a Contractor for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service, without permission of the Government. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the Contractor's Service.
7. The earnest money shall be forfeited, if-
 - a) Any bidder/ tenderer withdraws his bid/ tender during the period of bid validity or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid.
 - b) Failure of Successful bidder fails within the specified time limit to furnish the required performance security.
 - c) In case contractor fails to execute the agreement within 28 days after fixation of contract.
- 8.0. Instruction to bidders regarding e-tendering process.
- 8.1 Bidders are advised to download bid submission manual from the "Downloads" option as well as from "Bidders Manual Kit" on website www.jktenders.gov.in into acquaint bid submission process.
- 8.2. To participate in bidding process, bidders have to get 'Digital Signature Certificate (DSC)' as per Information Technology Act-2000. Bidders can get digital certificate from any approved vendors.

- 8.3. The bidders have to submit their bids online in electronic format with digital Signature. No financial bid will be accepted in physical form.
- 8.4. Bids will be opened online as per time schedule mentioned in Para-2.
- 8.5. Bidders must ensure to upload scanned copy of all necessary documents with technical bid. Besides, documents related to Technical bid be submitted physically before date of opening of technical bid.

Note: - Scan all the documents on 100 dpi with black and white option.

9. The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission due to any reasons.
10. Scanned copy of cost of tender document in shape of Demand Draft in favour of **Executive Engineer PHE Division Leh** and Earnest Money/Bid Security in shape of CDR/FDR if applicable pledged to Distt. Supdg. Engineer PWD Circle Leh must be uploaded with the technical documents of the bid. The original Demand Draft (cost of tender document), CDR/FDR (earnest money/bid security) and relevant technical bid documents etc be submitted to the tender opening authority by registered post/Courier/by hand before the date of receipt as specified above.
11. Bidders may contact office of the Distt. Supdg. Engineer PWD Circle, Leh or concerned Executive Engineer for any guidance for getting DSC or any other relevant details in respect of e-tendering process.
12. Bidders are advised not to make any change in BOQ (Bill of Quantities) contents. In no case they should attempt to create similar BOQ manually. The BOQ downloaded should be used for filling the item rate inclusive of all taxes and it should be saved with the same name as it contains.
13. The intending tenderers are advised to go through the following terms and conditions carefully before tendering for then work & the tender form shall not be issued if fails to fulfill the conditions:-
1. The contractor shall have get the cement mortar/cube testing done periodical y from the testing laboratory as per the instructions of the Engineer-in-charge to ensure good quality of work as per standard specifications
 2. The royalty of mining material consumed by the contractor shall be deducted at schedule rate issued time to time by the Geology Ming Deptt. Vide their circular No141-MNG/67 Dated:-29.02.2000.
 3. 1% cess shall be deducted from the contractor as per labour Deptt. circular issued time to time an account of Registration of contractor under building and other PHE works Act. of 1996this is in reference to labor court direction No: DLC/2010-11/cess/106 Dated:- 18.08.2010
 4. The tender opening authority reserve the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
 5. The contractor are required to get registered themselves from the office of the Commercial Tax Circle Leh. The service tax besides other taxes in vogue during the currency of contract shall be deducted on the total value of the contract at source and produce/Upload the service tax clearance certificate, failing which tender shall be rejected.
14. The intending tenderers are advised to go through the terms and conditions of the contract carefully before tendering for the work
15. The unit rates and prices shall be quoted by the bidder entirely in **Indian Rupees** and the rates quoted shall be deemed to include **price escalation and all taxes** upto completion of the work unless otherwise, specified.
16. Bidders are advised to use "My Documents" area in their user on PHE e-Tendering portal to store such documents as are required.
17. All key construction material (i.e. cement, steel, D.I Pipes/M.S pipes etc complete) shall have to be supplied by the contractor strictly as per specifications with the approval of Engineer-in-charge, the Contractor shall arrange the same on his own from authorized dealers for the above said work and quality of material shall have to be verified / passed by the concerned Asstt. Executive Engineer before start of work. The approved brand of Ductile Iron Pressure Pipes with socket and Spigot and conforming to IS:8329-2000 with latest amendments of standard length of 4.0, 5.0, 5.5 and 6.00 mtr. suitable for push on joint rubber gasket-D Jointing with inside cement motor lining and outside zinc coating with bitumen finish coat as per IS 8329-2000 with latest amendment hydro static test pressure as per BIS Code with EPDM rubber gasket conforming to IS 5382-1935 size 100 mm class K-9. The approved brand of cement / Tar steel are as under-
- I. JK Cement / Ambuja Cement
 - II. Tar Steel of SAIL/Jindal /Tata
18. Inspection of the material before dispatch to be got inspected by M/S CEIL /RITES
19. Defect Liability Period: 03 Years after date of completion.
20. Retention Money & Maintenance Liability:- An amount equal to 10% of the payments due shall be retained and treated as a deposit on account of retention money and maintenance liability for a period of (03) three years from the date of virtual completion of the work. The same shall be released after successful completion of maintenance liability for the said period as per schedule give below:-
- a) 50% of such deposit after One year of maintenance to be counted from Virtual date of completion.
 - b) 25% of such deposit after two years of maintenance to be counted from Virtual date of completion.
 - c) 25% of such deposit after three years of maintenance to be counted from Virtual date of completion.
- Note:-
- i. The maintenance liability will not include damages caused due to natural calamities like floods, earth quakes etc nor damages caused due to the damaged / leaking water supply pipelines.
 - ii. Any road cut conducted authorizedly or un- authorizedly by any Govt. Department/Private Enterprises / person shall not be the responsibility of the agency and will not be considered a defect of the work.
21. Qualification Criteria:- To qualify for award of contract, the bidder must demonstrate, having experience and resources sufficient to meet the aggregate of the qualifying criteria for the individual contracts:-

- 21.02. Un balanced Bid:-In case bid of the lowest bidder is found unbalanced, the successful bidder shall have to produce additional performance security in shape of CDR/ FDR within (07) days after opening of price bids, as per following break-up:-

22. Each bidder must produce:

- A copy of PAN issued by income Tax Authorities and
- An affidavit that the information furnished with the bid document is correct in all respects and
- Such other certificates as defined in the Bid Date Sheet. Failure to produce the certificates on demand shall make the bid non-responsive.

23. Labour for Traffic control/watch and ward as per necessity at site shall be supplied by the firm and nothing extra shall be paid in this behalf by the Department.

24. The Contractor are required to get registered themselves from the office of the Commercial Tax Circle Leh. The service tax besides other taxes in vogue during the currency of contract shall be deducted on the total value of the contract at source and produce/upload the service tax clearance certificate, failing which tender shall be rejected.

General Conditions

1. The date of start of the work shall be reckoned with one weeks from the issuance of the LO1/Contract allotment as the case may be

- Penalty for delay in completion, penalty up to 10% of the contract shall be imposed.
- No mobilization/equipment advance shall be paid.
- On completion of contract the contractor shall responsible to remove all un-used materials and restore all work in its original position at his own.
- The contractor shall also be responsible for any kind of damage to the public property.
- The contractors shall be solely responsible for carrying out the mandatory tests required for the quality control at his own costs.
- In case contractor failed to start/complete the work within the stipulated time period, his CDR/Earnest money shall be forfeited after termination of the contract.
All other terms and conditions will be the same as laid down in the NIT issued time to time and PWD form No.25 double leaf.
- The Contractor shall have to submit his own works programs and time bar chart conforming to the stipulated period of completion which shall eventually a part of the agreement.

25. No payment shall be made without conducting mandatory tests as per relevant IRC condition and SP 72.
